## **CATANIA WELCOMES \$420K+ ROYALTIES FOR REGIONS INVESTMENT IN YALGOO RD**

07 January 2013

Member for North West, Vince Catania has welcomed more than \$420,000 of *Royalties for Regions* funding for sealing works on the Yalgoo-Morawa Road.

Mr Catania said the investment was part of the latest round of the Country Local Government Fund.

“The sealing will have far reaching benefits for the communities of Yalgoo and Morawa, as well as visitors to the region,” Mr Catania said.

He said Morawa’s role as one of nine regional SuperTowns had the region poised for growth and the sealing would better enable all communities to take advantage of the increasingly improved amenities in the town.

“The completion of an all-weather route to Morawa will enable Yalgoo residents to access improved education, health and social facilities.

“Morawa business will also benefit from the clientele of Yalgoo residents.”

The works, which will see four kilometres of the road sealed, is particularly needed to facilitate the growing volume of heavy haulage traffic.

“The increase in truck passage as a result of the growing mining industry is causing the road to rapidly deteriorate, creating safety issues for drivers and increasing road maintenance costs for the Shire of Yalgoo,” Mr Catania said.

The Shires of Yalgoo and Morawa have been working together for many years to see the important route sealed. However the cost of the project has been an impediment to its progress.

“This project is a great example of the purpose of the Country Local Government Fund which is to empower local Governments to invest in projects they previously had not had the resources to do so.

“The Shires have indicated without *Royalties for Regions* funding the Yalgoo-Morawa Road would not be completely sealed until 2020.



“This timeframe that would greatly restrict the benefits the Yalgoo community reaped from its proximity to the SuperTown of Morawa,” Mr Catania said.

The Country Local Government Fund is a pillar of the *Royalties for Regions* programme. More than \$13 million will be invested in 20 regional local government projects as part of the latest round of the Country Local Government Fund.

# Recipes



## Chicken and cheese pasta bake recipe

Pasta bakes are always a big favourite with busy families. This pasta bake is fast to make because it uses a BBQ chicken and combines it with a delicious cheesy sauce that is dreamy to eat. Make plenty because you'll be asked for second helpings!

### INGREDIENTS:

- 1 BBQ chicken
- 500g dried rigatoni pasta
- 1 tbsp olive oil
- 2 garlic cloves, crushed
- 1 small red onion, finely chopped
- 500g jar tomato pasta sauce
- 2 cups grated mozzarella cheese
- 100g baby spinach leaves

### METHOD:

Remove skin and meat from chicken. Discard skin and bones. Roughly chop flesh.

Preheat oven to 180°C.

Cook pasta in a large saucepan of boiling salted water, following packet directions, until just tender. Drain. Return to saucepan.

Meanwhile, heat oil in a frying pan over medium-high heat. Add garlic and onion. Cook, stirring often, for 3 minutes or until tender.

Add onion mixture, pasta sauce, chicken, 3/4 cup cheese and baby spinach to hot pasta. Season with salt and pepper.

Toss gently until well combined. Spoon pasta mixture into a deep baking dish. Top with remaining cheese.

Bake for 15 to 20 minutes or until golden and heated through.

## Beef macaroni cheese

Ingredients 500g Beef mince 450g Jar of your favourite sauce  
1x grated carrot 400g dried macaroni 1 cup grated cheese

Method Brown mince in a frypan. Stir in bolognese sauce and carrot and simmer gently for 15 minutes. Cook macaroni in boiling salted water for 8 minutes or according to directions on packet. Drain and stir into the meat sauce. Spoon into baking dish and sprinkle over cheese. Bake at 180 C for

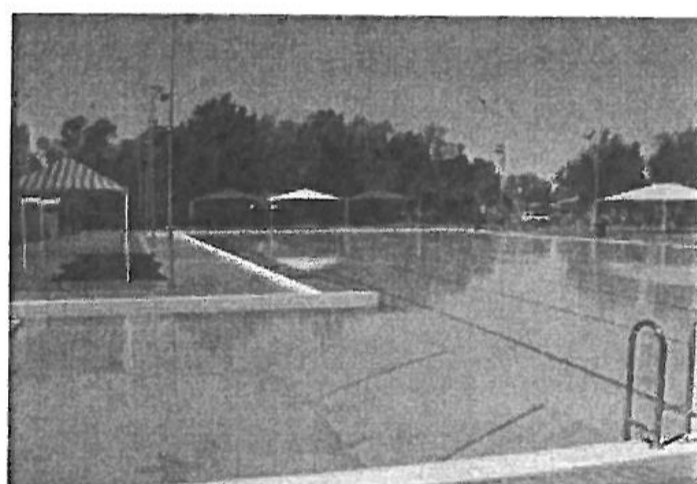
### 26<sup>th</sup> January - Yalgoo Australia Day Beach Party.

## Conversion to Digital TV in Yalgoo

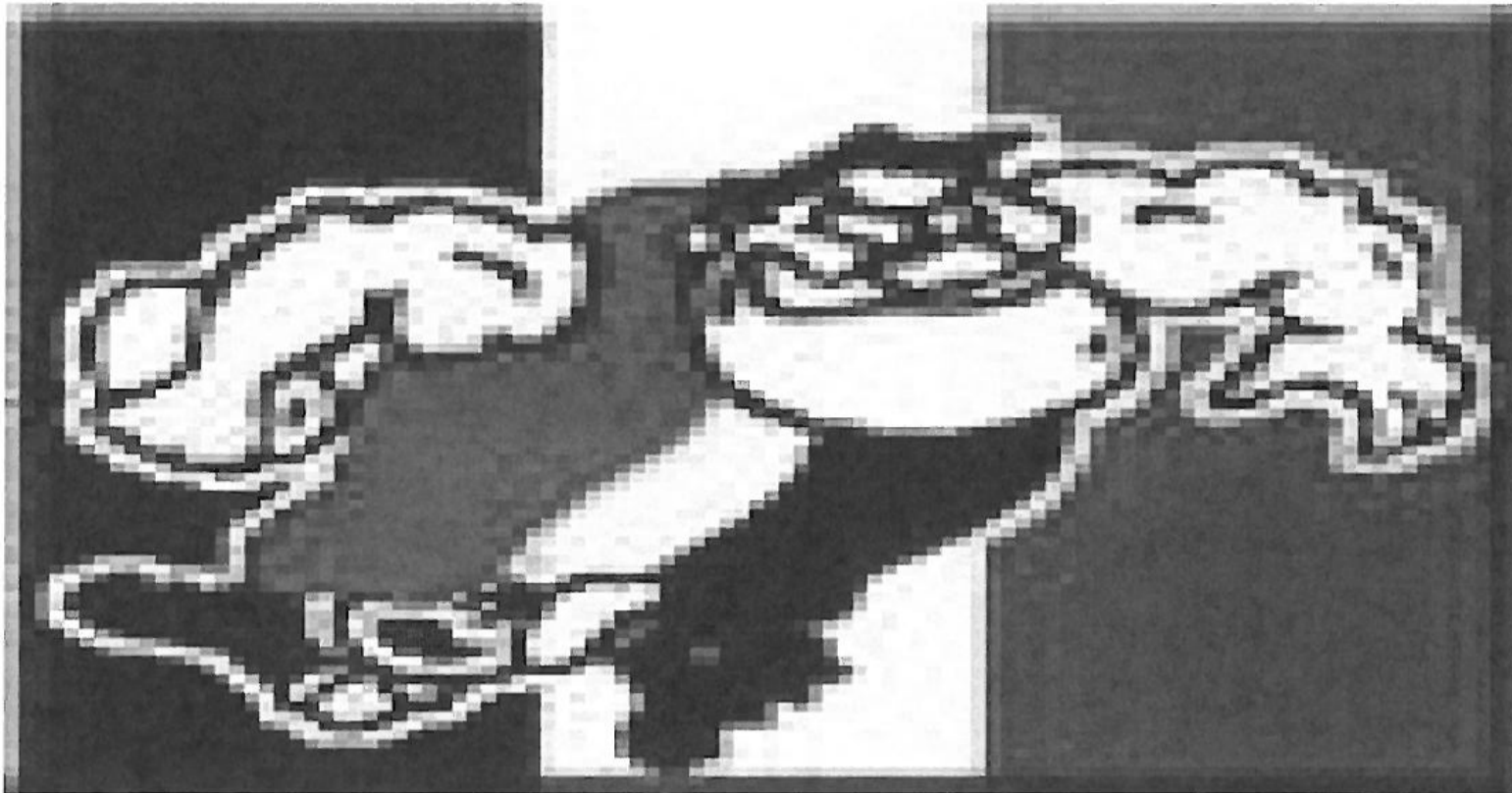

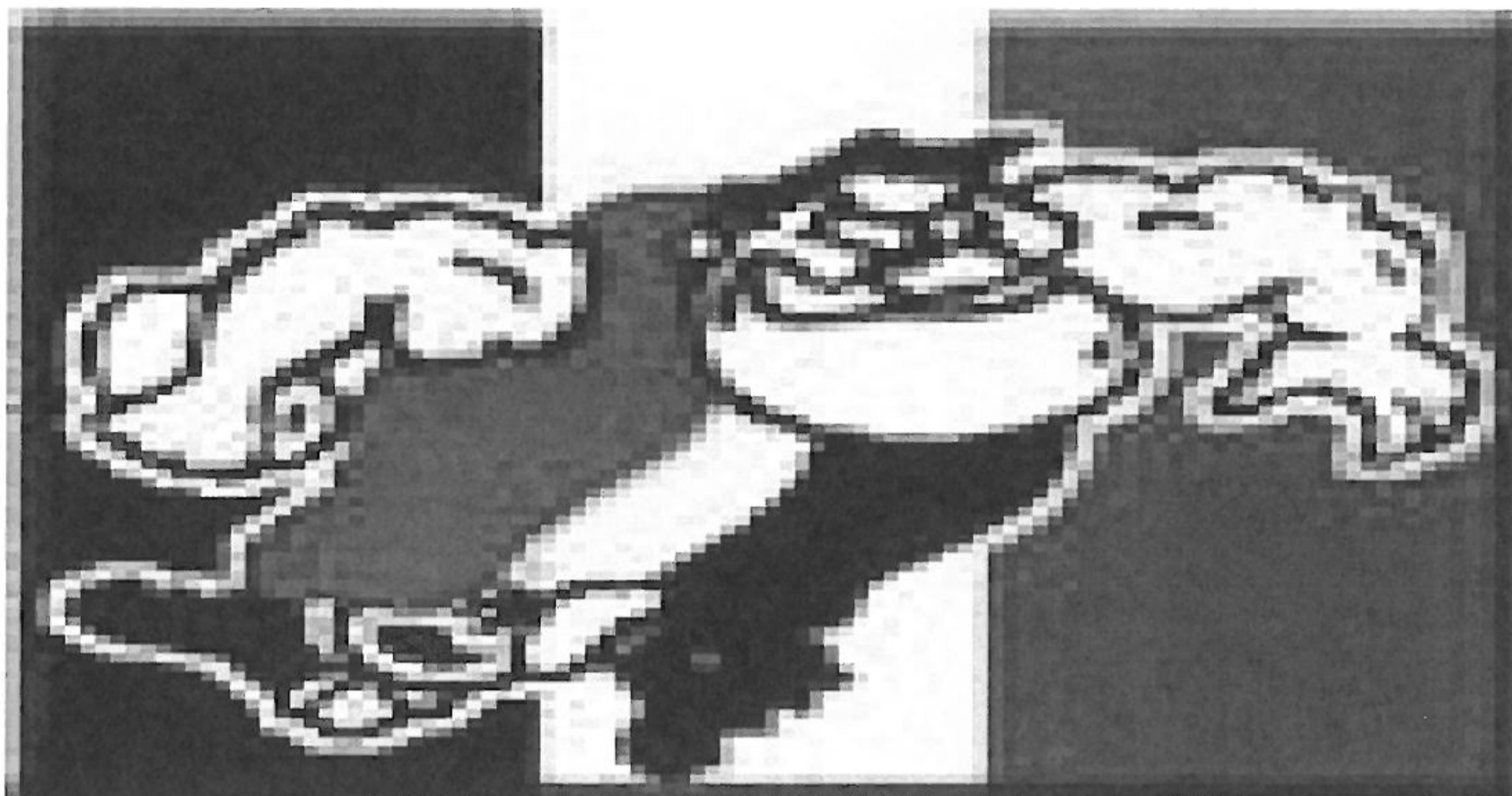

### **The Mully Saints HQ**

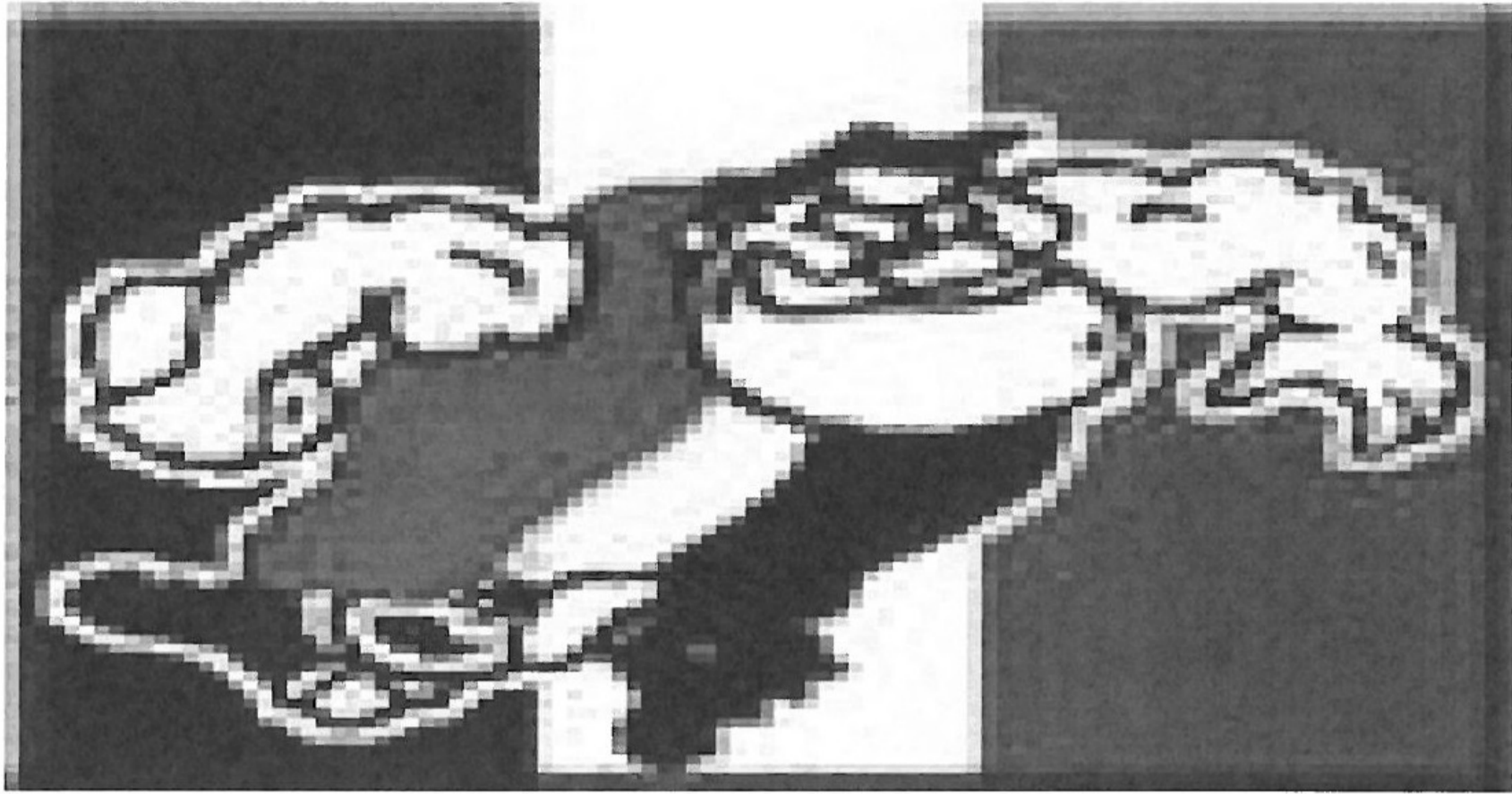
Those who were not aware the club has purchased the old landcare building next door to Thurkles.

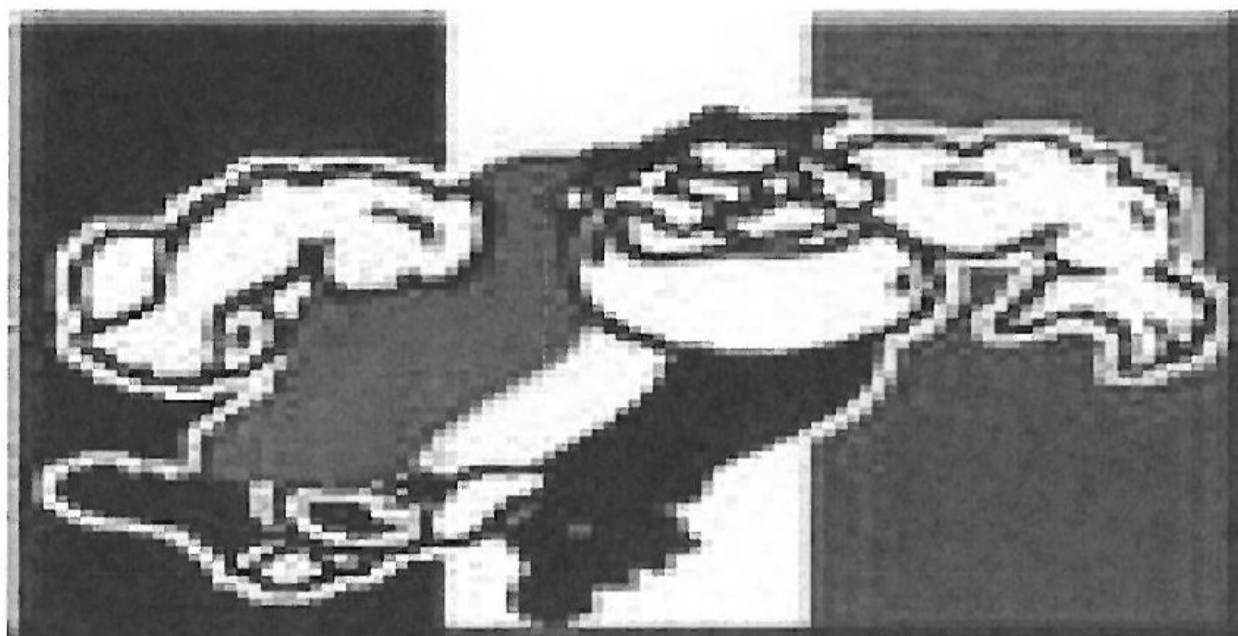

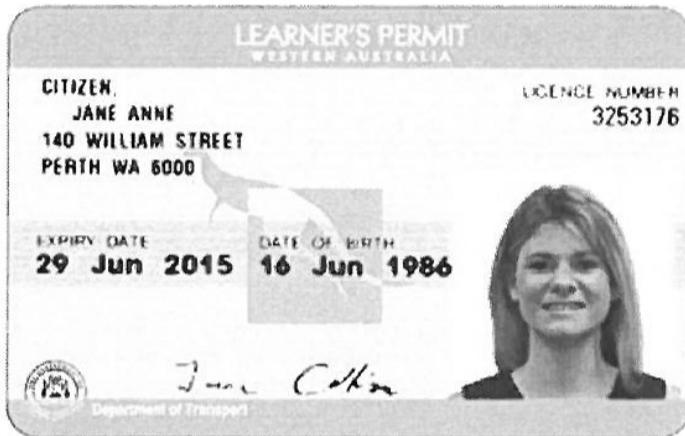

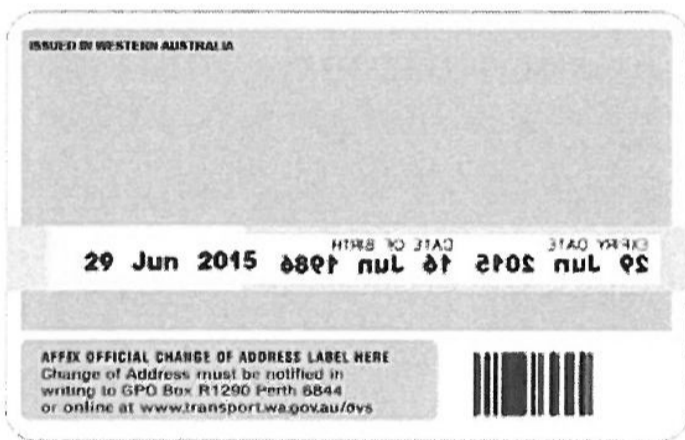
# New Western Australian Learner's Permit Card

The Department of Transport (DoT) is introducing a secure and durable learner's permit card.

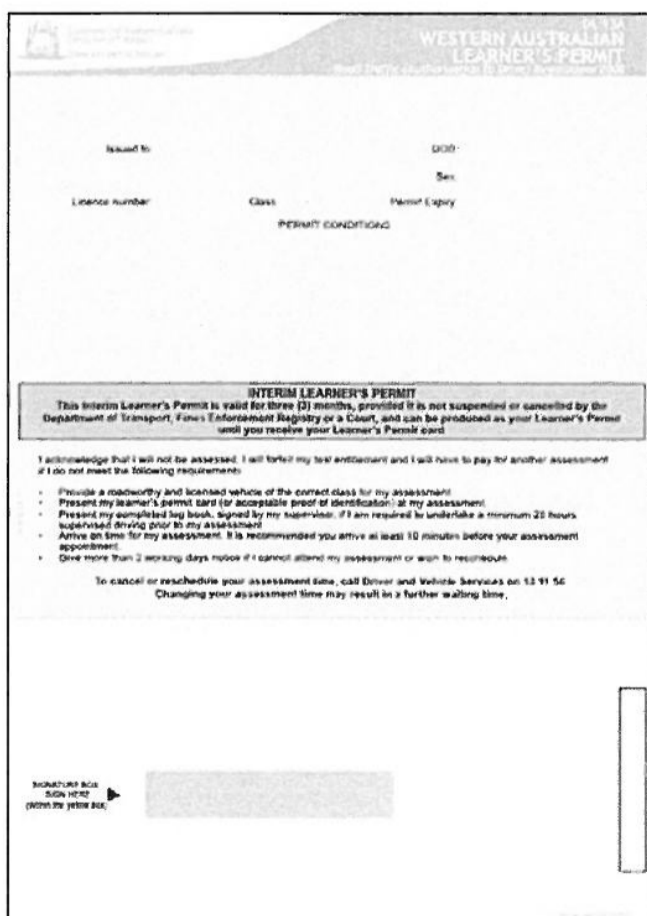
## NEW LEARNER'S PERMIT CARD

## Why the need for change?

The existing learner's permit is paper-based which can be open to fraudulent practices if it is lost or stolen. It was timely for the State Government to introduce a more secure photographic learner's permit card.

## What are the changes?

The new learner's permit card features a revised design and an increase in security features that exceeds world's best practice.

The increase in security features will make forgery of the card much more difficult and will act as a deterrent against identity crime.

Features include:

- a unique serial number on each learner's permit card
- printing over a clear panel
- holder's date of birth embossed under the photograph
- a holographic overlay of the State Coat of Arms
- special print in some areas.

## The process

Once the applicant is granted a learner's permit they will be issued with a paper-based Interim Learner's Permit. The learner's permit card will be sent in the mail within 14 days.

There is presently no requirement for existing learner's permit holders to obtain a photographic card where the original paper learner's permit is still valid.

Upon applying for a new, replacement or renewed learner's permit, the applicant will be required to obtain a learner's permit card.
